2nd Grade collected 346 cans and was recognized with free dress yesterday.

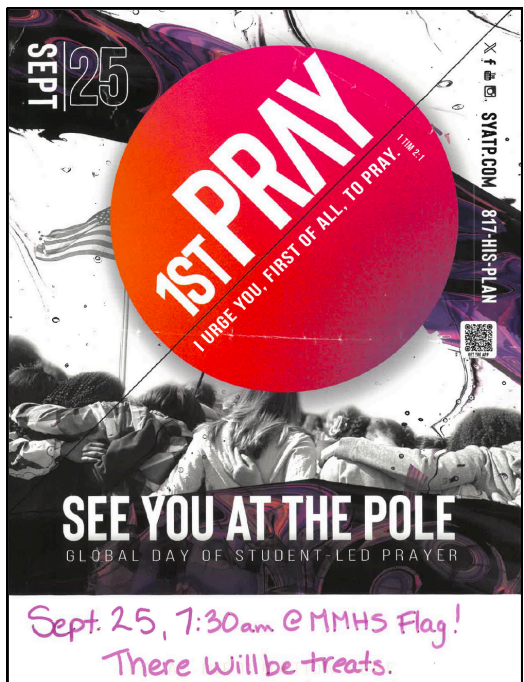
7th/8th Grade collected 100 cans and received homework passes for their efforts.
