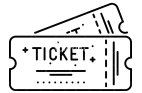

- **SFDS Read-A-Thon** Please remind your child to Read, Read, Read! Reading Logs are due every Friday.



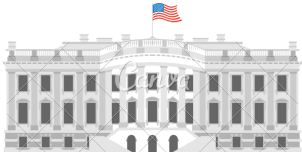
October is National Pretzel Month
